(NKJV)

Luke 5:12-13 While He was in one of the towns, there came a man full of (covered with) leprosy; and when he saw Jesus, he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, Lord, **if You are willing**, You are able to cure me and make me clean. And [Jesus] reached out His hand and touched him, saying, **I am willing**; be cleansed! And immediately the leprosy left him. (AMP)

Acts 1:1 The former account I made, O Theophilus, of all that **Jesus began both to do and teach**, (NKJV)

We respect the medical profession. We aren't anti-doctor. We pray for medical professionals and medicine. We thank God for all of these things. The Lord will lead you according to where your faith is.

Thank God for a Healer that can fix our problems. Don't be anti things. Be for things. Stay proactive and positive pursuing the substance of the Word of God that you obtain my faith.

***This is what Jesus began.** What you are about to read is **a continuation of what Jesus started.** What Jesus started, He is still doing. Jesus has anointed you to lay hands on the sick and continue His ministry exactly as He showed you by example in His ministry.*

The Ministry of Jesus hasn't ceased. The tomb is empty and Jesus is alive.

Acts 10:38 how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about **doing good and healing all** who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him. (NKJV)

Acts 3:1-16 Now Peter and John went up together to the temple at the hour of prayer, the ninth hour. And a **certain man lame from his mother's womb** was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms from those who entered the temple; who, seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple, asked for alms. And fixing his eyes on him, with John, Peter said, **"Look at us."** So he gave them his attention, expecting to receive something from them. Then Peter said, **"Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you: In the name of**

Jesus Christ of Nazareth, rise up and walk." And he took him by the right hand and lifted him up, and **immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.** So he, leaping up, stood and walked and entered the temple with them—**walking, leaping, and praising God.** And all the people saw him walking and praising God. Then they knew that it was he who sat begging alms at the Beautiful Gate of the temple; and they were filled with wonder and amazement at what had happened to him. Now as the lame man who was healed held on to Peter and John, all the people ran together to them in the porch which is called Solomon's, **greatly amazed.** So when Peter saw it, he responded to the people: **"Men of Israel, why do you marvel at this? Or why look so intently at us, as though by our own power or godliness we had made this man walk?** The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified His Servant Jesus, whom you delivered up and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let Him go. But you denied the Holy One and the Just, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you, and killed the Prince of life, whom God raised from the dead, of which we are witnesses. And His name, **through faith in His name, has made this man strong,** whom you see and know. **Yes, the faith which comes through Him has given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.** (NKJV)

Do we still have the Name of Jesus? Can we still have faith in His name? This sounds just like something that Jesus would do. It is something Jesus would do and He is still doing it.

Acts 5:14-16 And believers were increasingly added to the Lord, multitudes of both men and women, so that they **brought the sick out into the streets and laid them on beds and couches**, that at least the **shadow of Peter passing by might fall on some of them**. Also a multitude gathered from the surrounding cities to Jerusalem, bringing sick people and those who were tormented by unclean spirits, **and they were all healed**. (NKJV)

This sounds exactly like Jesus did and is continuing to do. This is what Jesus began.

Acts 8:4-8 Therefore those who were scattered went everywhere preaching the word. Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria and **preached Christ to them**. And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip, **hearing and seeing the miracles which he did**. For **unclean spirits, crying with a loud voice, came out of many who were possessed; and many who were paralyzed and lame were healed**. And there was great joy in that city. (NKJV)

Philip was a deacon in the church. He was a servant in the church who waited upon tables. This is a person just like us. Philip was a faithful worker in the church. This sounds just like something that Jesus would do.

Acts 14:3 Therefore they stayed there a long time, **speaking boldly** in the Lord, who was bearing witness to the word of His grace, **granting signs and wonders to be done by their hands**. (NKJV)

Acts 28:7-10 In that region there was an estate of the leading citizen of the island, whose name was Publius, who received us and **entertained us courteously for three days**. And it happened that the **father of Publius lay sick of a fever and dysentery**. Paul went in to him and prayed, and **he laid his hands on him and healed him**. So when this was done, the **rest of those on the island who had diseases also came and were healed**. They also honored us in many ways; and when we departed, they provided such things as were necessary. (NKJV)

Paul ministered healing to this man. Nothing is said about this man's faith. Paul ministered healing to this man. The rest of the people were healed.

A man heard Paul preaching. You can be just like this man. You can believe what the Word of God says. You can believe the Word of God is the Will of God. You can have faith to receive your healing by believing the Word of God.

Acts 14:7-10 And **they were preaching the gospel there**. And in Lystra a certain man without strength in his feet was sitting, a cripple from his mother's womb, who had never walked. **This man heard Paul speaking**. Paul, observing him intently and **seeing that he had faith to be healed**, said with a loud voice, **"Stand up straight on your feet!"** And **he leaped and walked**. (NKJV)

Everyone can be healed the way this man was healed. You can get into the Word for yourself and be healed every time. God will meet your faith. All He needs is for you to believe Him. He loves you.

Acts 4:24-31 So when they heard that, they raised their voice to God with one accord and said: **“Lord, You are God, who made heaven and earth and the sea, and all that is in them, who by the mouth of Your servant David have said: ‘Why did the nations rage, And the people plot vain things? The kings of the earth took their stand, And the rulers were gathered together Against the Lord and against His Christ.’”**“For truly against Your holy Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered together to do whatever Your hand and Your purpose determined before to be done. **Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word, by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus.”** And when they had prayed, **the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.** (NKJV)

REASON 21 GIFTS OF HEALINGS

1 Corinthians 12:7-11 But the **manifestation of the Spirit** is given to each one for the profit of all: for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit, to another faith by the same Spirit, **to another gifts of healings** by the same Spirit, **to another the working of miracles**, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. But one and the

same Spirit works all these things, **distributing to each one individually as He wills.** (NKJV)

You see manifestations of these gifts in the Book of Acts. These gifts of healings are gifts of a healing as the Spirit of God manifests. It's not true that a man can have a gift to turn off and on at will. Jesus is the healer. Keep your eyes on Jesus.

Acts 19:11-12 Now **God worked unusual miracles** by the hands of Paul, so that even **handkerchiefs or aprons were brought from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the evil spirits went out of them.** (NKJV)

God worked the special miracles. Paul did not work the special miracles. The Holy Ghost is in us and can come upon us to send anointing power into a cloth. The power can stay in a cloth for a time. God does special things. Peter's shadow was a special working of God.

Why does God do these kinds of things? Because it is the Will of God for healing restoration of all things. You don't have to understand what is wrong for it to be gone.

Peter, John and even Jesus could have walked by this man many times. But this day God gave them something to help the man.

Acts 3:16 And His name, **through faith in His name, has made this man strong,** whom you see and know. Yes, the **faith which comes through Him** has given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all. (NKJV)
