And [Jesus] reached out His hand and touched him, saying, I am willing; be cleansed! And immediately the leprosy left him. (AMP)

Your faith needs to be fed. As a pastor our job is to lead and feed. A curse is in the earth and we have an enemy who is trying to kill us. This is why we are taking this time to feed your spirit. You can't have too much Word in you. You can't overdose on the Word.

James 5:16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. (NKJV)

Forgives and heals. We need to combine these. You should not separate them. You don't put forgiveness in one place and healing in another. You are righteous, healed and rich in Christ Jesus. Jesus gave you righteousness, health and riches or provision.

Psalm 103:1-5 Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. (NKJV)

Faith simply just doesn't worry about anything. Joy and peace are the two gauges in your faith life you should watch. Faith produces joy and peace. If you run out of joy and peace you will be out of faith. Keep yourself full of the Word and your faith is trusting in God's Word you will keep your joy and peace.

You have to watch what you think about. You choose what you will think about. Make a choice to think about what God has said about your problems.

## FORGIVENESS and HEALING.

These two are part of redemption. They are not separate.

James 5:14-15 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. (NKJV)

You are aging but you can be renewed. God can renew your youth. God can fill your life with good things. I'm righteous, I'm healed, I'm rich. I'm being renewed.

Numbers 12:13-16 So Moses cried out to the Lord, saying, "Please heal her, O God, I pray!" Then the Lord said to Moses, "If her father had but spit in her face, would she not be shamed seven days? Let her be shut out of the camp seven days, and afterward she may be received again." So Miriam was shut out of the camp seven days, and the people did not journey till Miriam was brought in again. And afterward the people moved from Hazeroth and camped in the Wilderness of Paran. (NKJV)

Pray like it is written in scripture. Miriam got in trouble because she missed it. Missing God opens the door to the enemy. None of us can throw a stone at anyone else. We've opened the door through different ways. God can make it right.

Psalm 38:3-22 There is no soundness in my flesh Because of Your anger, Nor any health in my bones Because of my sin. For my iniquities have gone over my head; Like a heavy burden they are too heavy for me. My wounds are foul and festering Because of my foolishness. I am troubled, I am bowed down greatly; I go mourning all the day long. For my loins are full of inflammation, And there is no soundness in my flesh. I am feeble and severely broken; I groan because of the turmoil of my heart. Lord, all my desire is before You; And my sighing is not hidden from You. My heart pants, my strength fails me; As for the light of my eyes, it also has gone from me. My loved ones and my friends stand aloof from my plague, And my relatives stand afar off. Those also who seek my life lay snares for me; Those who seek my hurt speak of destruction, And plan deception all the day

long. But I, like a deaf man, do not hear; And I am like a mute who does not open his mouth. Thus I am like a man who does not hear, And in whose mouth is no response. For in You, O Lord, I hope; You will hear, O Lord my God. For I said, "Hear me, lest they rejoice over me, Lest, when my foot slips, they exalt themselves against me." For I am ready to fall, And my sorrow is continually before me. For I will declare my iniquity; I will be in anguish over my sin. But my enemies are vigorous, and they are strong; And those who hate me wrongfully have multiplied. Those also who render evil for good, They are my adversaries, because I follow what is good. Do not forsake me, O Lord; O my God, be not far from me! Make haste to help me, O Lord, my salvation!(NKJV)

**Psalm 39:13** Remove Your gaze from me, that **I may regain strength**, Before I go away and am no more." (NKJV)

**Psalm 41:10** But You, O Lord, be merciful to me, and raise me up, That I may repay them. (NKJV)

Jeremiah 17:13-14 O Lord, the hope of Israel, All who forsake You shall be ashamed. "Those who depart from Me Shall be written in the earth, Because they have forsaken the Lord, The fountain of living waters." Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; Save me, and I shall be saved, For You are my praise. (NKJV)

James 5:14-15 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the **prayer** of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. (NKJV)

Mark 11:24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them. (NKJV)

The prayer of faith isn't based upon what you see or feel. The prayer of faith is we believe that we receive our healing. It is not a prayer of begging.

## I'M RIGHTEOUS I'M HEALED I'M RICH IN CHRIST JESUS

James 5:16 Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much. (NKJV)

Now this is a different prayer that takes place when we've missed it. When we have sinned the sins shall be forgiven just as well as the healing.

We don't find the Will of God from what people have experienced or not experienced. We don't second guess God. Any adjustments are to be made are our responsibility. God has done everything possible to get us to the place. It is always God's Will to heal.
