### GOLDEN TEXT

**Luke 5:12** And it happened when He was in a certain city, that behold, a man who was full of leprosy saw Jesus; and he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, “**Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.**” Then He put out His hand and touched him, saying, “**I am willing; be cleansed.**” Immediately the leprosy left him. (NKJV)

**Luke 5:12-13** While He was in one of the towns, there came a man full of (covered with) leprosy; and when he saw Jesus, he fell on his face and implored Him, saying, Lord, **if You are willing**, You are able to cure me and make me clean. And [Jesus] reached out His hand and touched him, saying, **I am willing**; be cleansed! And immediately the leprosy left him. (AMP)

*In the Living Bible is written Jesus said **OF COURSE I WILL.***

### COMMENTS

*Can you find one place where Jesus said it is not the time for you to be healed? Everyone who ever came to Jesus to be healed were healed. Jesus ministered to multitudes. Jesus was an expression of the Will of God.*

*Who did the Lord redeem. Did He redeem only those who did everything perfectly. He redeemed those who had sinned. The curse has no right in your life.*

*He became a curse for us.*

*You must take this night and day. Get these scriptures in your mouth and say it. Take it in night and day. Use the time wisely. Give attention to the Word of God.*

*How do you know if it is working in you? The Word will quicken you. It will make you alive. Keep yourself in the book and read.*

*The devil is subtle. He keeps trying to convince folks that they're cursed. They aren't cursed but he keeps trying to tell folks they are. You must believe that you are already REDEEMED. Stop trying to get it.*

**Galatians 3:13-14** Christ has redeemed us **from the curse of the law**, having become a curse for us (for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. (NKJV)

**Galatians 3:13-14** Christ **purchased our freedom** [redeeming us] **from the curse (doom) of the Law [and its condemnation]** by [Himself] becoming a curse for us, for it is written [in the Scriptures], Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree (is crucified); [Deut. 21:23.] To the end that through [their receiving] Christ Jesus, the blessing [promised] to Abraham might come upon the Gentiles, so that we through faith might [all] receive [the realization of] the promise of the [Holy] Spirit. (AMP)

**Galatians 3:13-14** Christ **did redeem us from the curse of the law**, having become for us a curse, for it hath been written, 'Cursed is every one who is hanging on a tree,' that to the nations the blessing of Abraham may come in Christ Jesus, that the promise of the Spirit we may receive through the faith. (Young's Literal Translation)

**Galatians 3:13-14** But Christ has rescued us from the curse pronounced by the law. When he was hung on the cross, he took upon himself the curse for our wrongdoing. For it is written in the Scriptures, "Cursed is everyone who is hung on a tree." Through Christ Jesus, God has blessed the Gentiles with the same blessing he promised to Abraham, so that we who are believers might receive the promised Holy Spirit through faith. (New Living Translation)

**Galatians 3:13-14** Christ took away the curse the law put on us. He changed places with us and put himself under that curse. It is written in the Scriptures, "Anyone whose body is displayed on a tree is cursed." 14 Christ did this so that God's blessing promised to Abraham might come through

Jesus Christ to those who are not Jews. Jesus died so that by our believing we could receive the Spirit that God promised. (New Century Version.)

*I hate sickness and I hate poverty. Do you know why? God hates sickness and poverty.*

**John 10:10** The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. **I have come that they may have life**, and that they may have it more abundantly. (NKJV)

*When God's Will is done LIFE is manifested.*

**Psalm 107:2** Let the redeemed of the Lord say so...(NKJV)

**BLESSINGS Deuteronomy 28:1-14**

**REDEEMED FROM THE CURSE Deuteronomy 28:15-68**

*The power is good but if you cross the power it can hurt you. You don't want to be against God. You want to be with God. It's not God's fault if you disobey. You could've obeyed. The same covenant can be a blessing to you or it can curse you. You have to obey the covenant.*

**Deuteronomy 28:22** The Lord will strike you with consumption, with fever, with inflammation, with severe burning fever, with the sword, with scorching, and with mildew; they shall pursue you until you perish. (NKJV)

*Now it says the Lord will strike you but you have to understand what is meant here. Lord show me what I don't see.*

**Exodus 12:12-13** For I will pass through the land of Egypt on that night, and will strike all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt **I will execute judgment**: I am the Lord. Now the blood shall be a sign for you

on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you; and the plague shall not be on you to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt. (NKJV)

**12:22-23** And you shall take a bunch of hyssop, dip it in the blood that is in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two doorposts with the blood that is in the basin. And none of you shall go out of the door of his house until morning. For the Lord will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the Lord will pass over the door and **not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you.** (NKJV)

*Is God the destroyer? No this is judgement. Because the Lord passes judgement He states that He did it. It was allowed. It doesn't mean it is His Will.*

**Lamentations 3:32-33** Though He causes grief, Yet He will show compassion According to the multitude of His mercies. **For He does not afflict willingly,** Nor grieve the children of men. (NKJV)

**1 Corinthians 11:29-32** For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep. **For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged.** But when we are judged, we are chastened by the Lord, that we may not be condemned with the world. (NKJV)

*You can repent, judge yourself and not be judged. You judge yourself. You can receive forgiveness and no longer does the curse have a right in your life.*

**Deuteronomy 28:21** The Lord will make the plague cling to you until He has

consumed you from the land which you are going to possess. (NKJV)

*You have to believe you're **RIGHTEOUS**. You have been made **RIGHTEOUS**. You must believe on Jesus. You must not remain in sin and you won't repent. If you are in sin you know it. If the Lord has dealt with you and you are rebelling against Him you will know it.*

### **1 John 1:9**

*Confess your sin because He is faithful and just or has a right to forgive you because of what Jesus did and to cleanse you from all **UNRIGHTEOUSNESS**. I have been made **RIGHTEOUSNESS** of God **IN CHRIST JESUS**. If you are **RIGHTEOUS** then it is wrong for you to be cursed.*

**Deuteronomy 28:22** The Lord will strike you with consumption, with fever, with inflammation, with severe burning fever, with the sword, with scorching, and with mildew; they shall pursue you until you perish. (NKJV)

*What is provided by grace must be possessed by faith. A proper diagnosis isn't a requirement to be healed.*

**Deuteronomy 28:27** The Lord will strike you with the boils of Egypt, with tumors, with the scab, and with the itch, from which you cannot be healed. (NKJV)

**Deuteronomy 28:35** The Lord will strike you in the knees and on the legs with severe boils which cannot be healed, and from the sole of your foot to the top of your head. (NKJV)

**Deuteronomy 28:28** The Lord will strike you with madness and blindness and confusion of heart. (NKJV)

**Deuteronomy 28:65** And among those nations you shall find no rest, nor shall the sole of your foot have a resting place; but there the Lord will give you a trembling heart, failing eyes, and anguish of soul. (NKJV)

**Deuteronomy 28:66** Your life shall hang in doubt before you; you shall fear day and night, and have no assurance of life. (NKJV)

**Deuteronomy 28:59** then the Lord will bring upon you and your descendants extraordinary plagues—great and prolonged plagues—and serious and prolonged sicknesses. (NKJV)

*This covers inherited things. You have been redeemed from anything passed on by your parents or grandparents. Don't let it run in the family.*

**Deuteronomy 28:60-61** Moreover He will bring back on you all the diseases of Egypt, of which you were afraid, and they shall cling to you. Also **every sickness and every plague, which is not written in this Book of the Law**, will the Lord bring upon you until you are destroyed (NKJV)
