2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us. (NKJV)

Is healing included in the plan of redemption? If it is, then it belongs to everybody because redemption is for everybody. Healing is an integral part of the plan of redemption. Healing was an integral part of the ministry of Jesus.

There is no blessing apart from the spotless Lamb of God who would shed His own blood. It was all based upon what Jesus would do and has done. The Old Testament looked forward to the finished work of Jesus Christ. It is all done in Jesus Christ. You are just as healed as you are forgiven.

Type 4 Atonement for the plague Numbers 16:41-50 On the next day all the congregation of the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron, saying, “**You have killed the people of the Lord.**” Now it happened, when the

congregation had gathered **against Moses and Aaron**, that they turned toward the tabernacle of meeting; and suddenly the cloud covered it, and the glory of the Lord appeared. Then Moses and Aaron came before the tabernacle of meeting. And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, **“Get away from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment.”** And they fell on their faces. So Moses said to Aaron, “Take a censer and put fire in it from the altar, put incense on it, and take it quickly to the congregation and make atonement for them; for wrath has gone out from the Lord. **The plague has begun.**” Then Aaron took it as Moses commanded, and ran into the midst of the assembly; and already the plague had begun among the people. So he put in the incense and **made atonement for the people**. And he **stood between** the dead and the living; so the plague was stopped. Now those who died in the plague were fourteen thousand seven hundred, besides those who died in the Korah incident. So Aaron returned to Moses at the door of the tabernacle of meeting, **for the plague had stopped.** (NKJV)

Unthankfulness makes you stupid. You see less and less. Something can be right in front of you and you can't see it.

Do we have a high priest today? Did Jesus make atonement for you? Jesus stands between you and destruction.

Hebrews 4:14-16 Seeing then that **we have a great High Priest** who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, **let us hold fast our confession.** For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points

tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need. (NKJV)

Hebrews 3:1 Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the **Apostle and High Priest of our confession**, Christ Jesus, (NKJV)

He is the apostle and High Priest over what you say. What should you say? If He says you're healed what should you say?

1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one God and **one Mediator between God and men**, the Man Christ Jesus (NKJV)

Type 5 Numbers 21:4-9 Then they journeyed from Mount Hor by the Way of the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; and the soul of the people became very discouraged on the way. And the people **spoke against God and against Moses: “Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and our soul loathes this worthless bread.”** So the Lord sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people; and many of the people of Israel died. Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, **“We have sinned, for we have spoken against the Lord and against you; pray to the Lord that He take away the serpents from us.”** So Moses prayed for the people. Then the Lord said to Moses, **“Make a fiery serpent, and set it on a pole; and it shall be that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, shall live.”** So Moses made a bronze serpent, and put it on a pole; and so it was, if a serpent had bitten anyone, when he looked at the bronze serpent, he lived. (NKJV)

Complaining opens the door to the destroyer in your life. God is not your problem. Have you obeyed Him? Don't complain about what you believe God hasn't done for you.

It was Israel's fault they weren't already in the promised land. They wanted to blame someone rather than take responsibility for why they were in the wilderness. So they blamed God and they blamed Moses.

Don't yield to complaining. Don't let those words come out of your mouth.

This is a type of Jesus. This is a type of healing. Jesus was lifted up on a pole.

John 3:14-21 And as **Moses lifted up** the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the **Son of Man be lifted up**, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. For **God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world**, but that the world through Him might be saved. **“He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already**, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And **this is the condemnation**, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God.” (NKJV)

Romans 5:11 And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we **have now received the reconciliation.** (NKJV)

You can't have faith until condemnation is removed. Condemnation is the faith destroyer. You can't have confidence in God with condemnation.

Brass is typical of judgment. A snake is typical of sin and evil. The cross was like the electric chair or lethal injection. The cross was the death penalty. Jesus was treated and judged as sin. Jesus became sin. Jesus became sin with our sin.

You are free from sin. Your sin has already been judged and put away. Our sins are gone. You are free from sickness. You have been healed by the stripes that Jesus bore upon His body.

You have been given the right to come boldly before the Throne of Grace. You can come through the Righteousness.

2 Corinthians 5:19-21 that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and **has committed to us the word of reconciliation.** Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. For He made Him who knew no sin **to be sin for us**, that we might become **the righteousness of God in Him.** (NKJV)
